THISHEARTSFORYOU pressed early wresting a clear lead on the turn, widened in the three path upper stretch holding firm under a drive. HIGHLAND HOLIDAY tracked the pace through the turn, bid five then six wide down the stretch securing place. STORM CLOUD COMING ducked out at the break, gained on the turn coming six wide in upper stretch, angled to the seven path late gave an even finish. GO GONE GIRL chased the pace along the inside through the turn, weakened near the rail in upper stretch. EMILY SUN SHINE broke alertly laying close up, clipped heels dropping off near the seven sixteenths pole, rushed to recover on the turn then flattened out in upper stretch. SARAH DOUGLAS away slowly saved ground to upper stretch finding no surge there. ROCK 'N' ROLL GAL played no factor. THE NATIVE BLAZE was always outrun. HONOUR FIRST broke sharply to the early lead, ceded on the turn giving way to upper stretch.
