SCORING CHICK broke alertly and angled towards the inside, was content to let SUK go on to the set the pace entering the far turn, sat patient racing up close, angled out entering the stretch, took over in upper stretch, was headed form both sides inside the eighth pole, dug in under severe pressure holding off rivals coming to the wire winning fully extended. LOLA'S RIDGE raced up close tracking a hot pace, bid three to four wide top of the lane, almost drew even with the winner mid stretch, fought hard under an all out drive to the wire, missed late and settled for second place in a hard effort. BEHAVE stalked early on traveling a little off the rail, angled inside mid stretch, vied in a three way battle from the sixteenth pole, was outfinished nearing the wire and settled for third best. GRILLEDHAM'NCHEESE was rated early, sat patient to mid turn, angled out five wide mounting rally top of the stretch, loomed to mid stretch chasing a trio of duelers, flattened out needing more. SUK rushed to the front, set a pressured pace to top of the stretch, had little left with a furlong to go and gave way. BEN'S HONOR was quickly outrun, trailed throughout racing along the inside.
