**Footnotes**

PINDERS GAP reserved in the early going, gained mid turn, waited behind a wall of rivals at the quarter pole, split foes at the three sixteenths, vied in a four way battle mid stretch, drew off at the sixteenth pole to win going away. GAME APPEAL settled in the second flight, rallied four wide entering the stretch, vied abreast rivals mid stretch, was outfinished by the winner in deep stretch while just holding on to second place under an all out drive. CAN'T BE PETE unhurried early and trailed briefly, rallied mid turn racing mid track, came four to five wide under strong left handed stick in upper stretch, closed willingly just missing second place. SAVTHELASDANCEFOME stalked the pace saving ground, cut the corner turning for home and put a head in front briefly at the furlong marker, had nothing left with a sixteenth to go giving way. UNTUTTABLE MOMENT stalked from the start, took control mid turn, headed from both sides entering the stretch, dueled to upper stretch then weakened in the final furlong. SAY NEW YORK SANDY well placed throughout, bid four wide on the bend and loomed off the leader at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move and flattened out upper stretch. COPE WITH BILL raced towards the rear running inside, urged mid turn, failed to respond never factoring. TIM HAS MONEY raced sluggishly and trailed to the quarter pole, offered little. SOUND THE CHARGE raced mid pack to the half traveling off the rail, gave way entering the stretch and finished being eased across the wire. DAD AREWETHEREYET hustled to the top, set the pace for the opening half mile, gave way at the quarter pole and stopped upper stretch finishing spent.
