LANDED ON THE MOON tracked the pace ranging up to challenge four deep on the turn, dueled abreast rivals in upper stretch edging up under full extension. ASSET PLAY never far back fired along the inside on the turn dueling from the rail to upper stretch, extending late would cede grudgingly to outside pressure. B'JIMNEY stalked the pace pressing up to challenge on the far turn, came between horses in the three path upper stretch angling out to mid track late. FIJI STAR (ARG) broke alertly prompted the pace under pressure through the far turn, dueling from the two path down the stretch would come up a bit short. WEATHERBEE prompted the pace through the backside, wavered on the far turn dropping off at mid track in upper stretch. UNSTOPPABLE MICK was never involved circling out six wide into upper stretch. TEN MARTINIS stalked close up for half a mile then gave way on the far turn. SCOTTKEITH'SKITTEN prompted the pace through the backside then gave way along the inside on the far turn.
