HOLLYWOOD BEAR went evenly advancing to contention on the turn, bid four deep in upper stretch edging clear late under full extension. SHY LOVER breaking sharply was hustled to keep a head in front through the turn, dueled between horses in two path upper stretch ceding grudgingly late. CROFTER stalked early pressing up to challenge on the turn, bid from the three path behind a trio of rivals in mid stretch hanging late. BIG BABY off slowly came five wide into upper stretch gaining position with even action. THE RAG MAN chased then pressed the pace through the turn, dueled in upper stretch wearing down late. D' BULLDOG was bumped by KING THOU ART steadying near the five eighths pole, rushed into the turn bid from the rail into upper stretch weakening late. KING THOU ART drifted in bumping D'BULLDOG near the five eighths pole, chased into the turn then gave way in the four path from the quarter pole. CHARLES THE HAMMER slow early played no factor. RHYD Y BLEW INN was always outrun. MR. BILLY N MR. S dropped back early.
