Footnotes

TETON PASS stalked the pace through the turn looming into upper stretch, hooked ROYAL RED SECRET a sixteenth out extending up abreast rival in the three path. ROYAL RED SECRET broke alertly pressing on a short lead through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch then was engaged by TETON PASS near the sixteenth pole, battled inside of rival ceding grudgingly late. SMOOTH TOWN stalked early dropping off the leaders on the turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch came on to finish well. LION'S REIGN slow early swung out seven wide in upper stretch gaining position. LIFEINTHETROPICS chased early then dropped back on the turn, came four wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. BIG CHAMP slow early played no factor. GRUBBY'S GIFT was always outrun. SUZANNE'S FRIEND broke sharply pressuring the pace through the turn, wavered in upper stretch giving way in the four path. GOOD QUESTION was jammed between horses stumbling at the break, dropping far back was eased on the turn.
