Footnotes

PROUD TEARS broke sharply sprinting up along the rail to shake clear into the turn, remained full of run opening up at the head of the stretch, went in full command winning under wraps. MISS BONN BONN hustled early between horses, saved ground dropping off on the turn, cut the corner rallying at the head of the lane, gave steady surge to secure place. REASONABLE CODE race evenly losing ground into the turn, came six wide to upper stretch, gave solid response under a drive. DAD SAYS YES away slowly, labored well back on the turn, taken eight wide in upper stretch, found belated stride finishing well. PIERSIXER outrun early, varied little on the turn, had a mild rally in upper stretch, finished evenly. CONQUER THE DAY sent hard pressuring on pace to the turn, chased PROUD TEARS under stiff urging to upper stretch, became clearly no match there wearing out under the whip. SET TO SPARKLE broke sharply engaging the early pace, ceded to PROUD TEARS chasing rival through the turn, was worn out inside the eighth pole giving way there. MOOGEDY was always outrun. THIS ONE FOR ABBEY hustled out with early speed, retreated soon after entering the turn coming empty to upper stretch. FULL TIME DANCER broke alertly pressing rivals four wide on the pace, chased to mid turn wavering near the three sixteenths pole, folded up at the head of the lane.
