**Footnotes**

LOOKWHATIGOT showed good speed stalking GLEAMING HALO soon after the start, pressed around the bend, drew even mid stretch and then slowly edged away late under strong handling. GLEAMING HALO hustled to the front, set a pressured pace throughout, fought hard with the winner from top of the stretch, yielded grudgingly in deep stretch proving a game second best. DYNARAN broke out to bump TETON GOLD leaving the gate, settled in mid pack, rallied five wide entering the stretch, chased top pair under a stiff drive but failed to menace, bested rest. TETON GOLD was bumped at the break by DYNARAN, hustled up to stalk running four wide, chased under urging from the quarter pole, lacked kick and tired in the drive. MARTINI JANE lost footing at the break and took up briefly, rushed up to stalk traveling three wide, began to tire leaving the quarter pole despite being hard ridden, no factor in the stretch run. PATTON'S STAR lacked speed and raced mid track throughout, offered little. VENUS DRIVE raced evenly in the second flight, saved ground around the turn, angled in upper stretch under a drive, failed to factor. POKEY CAT was always outrun, never involved.
