MAESTRO MISS stalked the pace through the backside responding on the far turn advancing from the quarter pole to wrest the lead into upper stretch, digging in from the four path there held clear. MARGIE ONE unhurried early gave a quick move on the far turn chasing MAESTRO MISS from the three path in upper stretch, going full out from the eighth pole continued to respond late. CHISELING NICKIE slow early rallied on the far turn angling out to the six path in upper stretch, though making no headway on the top pair responded willingly the final eighth. URA WILD WON slow early gained ground on the far turn, lost momentum in upper stretch going evenly in the three path the final eighth. KEEN SOTO raced evenly in mid pack to the half, drew to leaders on the far turn then leveled off at mid track in upper stretch. SPICEY DISH tracked the pace surging to loom boldly on the far turn, weakened along the inside in upper stretch. IMANUPTOWNGIRL losing ground early was never involved. CHILE TEQUILA sent clear set the pace through the backside, reeled in on the far turn would give way from the quarter pole. SOUTHCOTE ROAD lost ground laboring throughout. PRETTY MOMMA was eased when riders rein broke.
