SHELBY'S A PRO fog, angled four wide in upper stretch surging clear under a brisk drive. TOES ON THE CURB fog, circled out in upper stretch, responded from the eighth pole bidding willingly near mid track. BELLARIFFIC fog, chased early along the inside, cut the corner to upper stretch, vied gamely late from the rail. EMPIRE LADY fog, hustled in mid pack bid between horses in the two path upper stretch, stayed on to the end. CONGAREESBUTTERCUP fog, slow early came five wide upper stretch, proved no menace there. PULLING FOR DIXIE fog, always outrun raced seven wide through the stretch. KRISTINA'S MARK fog, chased early then gave way to upper stretch. BLAZIN' BLUES fog, broke sharply setting the early pace, folded under pressure to upper stretch. STARSHIP TRUTH fog, was eased through the stretch. DENSE FOG PROHIBITED A THREE EIGHTHS CALL FROM BEING MADE.
