ALLSAROTT unhurried in the early going rallied three wide on the far turn advancing to draw even abreast BANK OF DAD in upper stretch, would extend in the late going to edge clear. BANK OF DAD was sent up for the early lead, joined by BY SPOT would work the pace clinging to a short lead through the turn, collared by a fresh ALLSAROTT in upper stretch would cede grudgingly along the inside. HOT CHILI tracked the pace evenly through the far turn, angled out in upper stretch proved no match while holding the others well safe. TENMOR slow early played no factor. BY SPOT (BRZ) was hustled out engaging BANK OF DAD at the front forcing the pace racing inside of rival through the far turn, joined by ALLSAROTT nearing the stretch would give way there. RAMBLIN MIKE failed to respond. GALLARDO reared up missing the break, trailed to the far turn giving a brief move there before flattening in upper stretch.
