Footnotes

JEFF'S PAPER BOOTS was sent clear leading the way through the turn, widened into upper stretch holding firm in the two path. SIR EATSALOT slow early rallied along the inside to upper stretch, angled to the three path clearing as second best. MONIKER'S TUNE stalked the pace looming close up through the turn, extended in the two path down the stretch would weaken. ALLENSBACH raced evenly gaining on the turn, leveled off at mid track in upper stretch. IMITATION OF LIFE a step slow early was hustled with little improvement on the turn, put away down the stretch racing six and seven wide. CRY NO MORE faded along the inside on the turn. OCHO CINCO EYES angled out early, put away on the turn raced seven wide there then nine wide through the lane. T. G. 'S EXPLORER struggled throughout. MY BENANDONNER labored racing along the inside.
