COUNTRY IN hustled from the gate, dueled to mid turn, cleared at the quarter pole, increased margin late under strong urging. l'VEGOTTABEME stalked the winner throughout, angled to the tree path upper stretch under an all out drive, was turned away inside the furlong marker while easily proving second best. LAKE LUCERNE settled in the second flight, launched rally cutting the corner entering the stretch, surged late winning the battle for third place. HE'S A DIXIE BOY lacked speed racing towards the rear, swung six wide upper stretch, battled abreast rivals vying for a minor award, was out nodded late missing third place. TIN SOLDIER settled in the second flight, came four wide into the lane, raced between foes in deep stretch battling for a minor award, was outfinished nearing the wire. BAND PLAYER pressed the winner soon after the start, raced up close to the quarter pole, weakened from upper stretch. VOCABULARY lagged far off the early pace, passed a couple of weary foes late but never factored. SEA DOCTOR raced briefly in mid pack, gave way leaving the quarter pole racing wide. DENIZEN rushed a four wide move at the quarter pole and loomed off the winner, failed to sustain move and gave way mid stretch.
