FASTER THAN FLASH was hustled out in pursuit drawing even three deep to upper stretch, extended abreast CLASSY WONDER would draw out late. CLASSY WONDER was sent hard pressing the pace dueling into upper stretch, all out inside of FASTER THAN FLASH would wear down hanging on for place. MASCARON was slow early varying little through the turn, responded in upper stretch angling out while gaining late. FUNKY COUNTRY gave hard pursuit though the turn circling to mid track in upper stretch, would weaken under a brisk drive. BOLDER COURSE broke alert pressuring the pace matching strides with CLASSY WONDER through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading along the rail. FOREMOST RULER dropped off on the turn. LAKE LUCERNE chased early then wore down at mid track in upper stretch. MAXIMUM SECURITY slow early finished wide. CHANCE'S CODE was always outrun. AFRIKON was always a step slow.
