SAINT LEON prompted to grab the early lead moved off on pace going well clear in upper stretch, in full command the final eighth came home under hand urging. KING TALLYMON raced evenly while saving ground through the turn, was cut off by HERE'S BEAUREGARD and forced to steady outside the eighth pole, recovered nicely angling out then closing willingly as second best. MANTEO was bumped and carried inside by HERE'S BEAUREGARD at the break, settled well back angled out in upper stretch rallying past others. HERE'S BEAUREGARD stumbled leaving the gate crowding MANTEO in the process, was rushed to recover pursuing SAINT LEON under hard asking through the turn, became weary in upper stretch lugging in and shutting off KING TALLYMON before giving way. RAKA hesitated breaking late, was hustled in second flight through the turn giving even action down the lane. CHEYCONS REVENGE played no factor. A STAR FOR JESSIE was always outrun. BUCKSHOT labored throughout. KAZ JR. flashed early speed then quickly retreated on the turn. GOLD CASE JUSTIN folded up on the turn.
