CHARLIES FIRE broke sharply carrying a clear lead widening through the turn into upper stretch, moved in full command the final eighth. DEBS PRETTYGIRL tracked the pace emerging off a loose CHARLIES FIRE in upper stretch, no match for the winner stayed on well in the four and five path securing place. BELLARIFFIC tracked the pace angling out into the turn, came five wide in upper stretch gaining then holding position at mid track. MANDATEFOREMILY slow early raced four wide to upper stretch passing tired ones there. THREE COOKIES chased the pace saving ground to upper stretch weakening there along the rail. NOT ME BUT U slow early played no factor. BOLD PEAKS hustled out gave hard pursuit through the turn then faded in the six path upper stretch. LIGHT SLEEPER was always outrun. FRIENDLY MISS showed little.
