Footnotes

GUSKA'S GOLD rushed hard and cleared early, set all the pace traveling in the two path, was kept to task in the final furlong holding safe to the finish. TWELVE HUNDRED stalked the winner down the backside racing three wide, gave chase under an all out drive from upper stretch, needed a bit more late while digging in at the wire saving second place. BLITZ ECLIPSE showed good early foot pressing the winner to the far turn running along the rail, was kept in close by the winner and the runner up during the stretch drive, was edged for second place finishing a game third. SWORD AND SHIELD trailed early racing off the rail, angled out four wide upper stretch, improved placing but failed to menace. CLEANSED raced wide down the backside and trailed around the turn, failed to factor. POLITE LIL SIR raced a bit off the rail tracking the pace to the far turn, roused giving chase at the quarter pole, lacked rally never factoring in the drive. THUNDER MINISTER took a bad step going into the far turn and was pulled up, rider dismounted at the three eighths pole.
