Footnotes

HALO VICTORY stalked the pace in hand, asked near the quarter pole, bid four wide to vie for the lead entering the stretch, began to draw off inside the eighth pole, won driving. STITCHY WOMAN broke alertly, set a pressured pace, lost the lead mid turn, came again to vie between rivals in upper stretch, proved no match for the winner, gamely held the pace position. WHAT A PAL rated early on, hard ridden leaving the quarter pole, almost drew even near the eighth pole running on the rail, was out finished late. JUSTA JESSABELLE lacked speed, traveled towards the inside in the second flight, found stride late and angled out mid stretch, finished with interest but was no threat. JACKIE IN THE BOX hustled from the gate, pressed and then took command mid turn, battled while between rivals in upper stretch, was all done in deep stretch. GRACIE LOU veered in at the start herding RUNAWAY MS. ROLFE, hustled to mid pack, had no response when called upon. RUNAWAY MS. ROLFE was squeezed and taken up leaving the gate, raced off the rail early, did improve placing late but was no factor. REISS'S HALO stumbled and swerved in at the break, rushed to contention, chased while four wide mid turn, gave way mid stretch. EMERALD'S SECRET was off a step slow and in tight shortly after the start, swung very wide into the lane, offered little. BIG WAY was always outrun, never involved.
