Footnotes

ELIZABETH'S DREAM broke sharply wrestling and nursing a short lead through the turn, opened up top stretch being ridden out near the rail. SILVER FLATTERS pressed then chased through the turn, extending in the three path down the stretch held as second best. LOONEY LYNDIA was crowded by LEADER OF THE LITE after the break, saved ground through the turn gaining then holding position on the inside. SHEA STADIUM away slowly came four path upper stretch improving with even action. LOLA'S RIDGE chased early, began to waver on the turn fading from mid track down the stretch. REASON TO WINK dropped back along the inside on the turn. HEART OF ROSE chased between early, weakened on the turn fading six wide in upper stretch. TY WONDER gave hard pursuit through the turn then wore out at mid track in upper stretch. LEADER OF THE LITE in tight after the break would labor racing seven wide through the stretch. SILVER VOW was pinched back near the seven sixteenths pole.
