GO FAR FITZ away slowly trailed through the backside, began to respond on the far turn advancing in the two path upper stretch, angling abreast WEAGLE was carried out to the six path by the pacesetter edging clear late. WEAGLE sent clear set the pace on soft splits through the far turn, engaged from the outside in mid stretch angled out carrying GO FAR FITZ toward mid track ceded the issue late. SOLOMON'S FLAG slow early stayed back through the far turn, circled six wide in upper stretch gave an even finish. CONSPIRACY OF LOVE stalked the pace chasing through the far turn, wore out in the three path upper stretch. MANDATE LANE raced evenly through the far turn flattening out into upper stretch. NORTHERN MONARCH failed to respond. MCBEAN outrun early would tire. GO FAR FITZ WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED DUE TO A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
