PROUD WARRIOR well placed saving ground down the backside, bid along the rail mid turn, dueled with PLEASURE PEAKS to the quarter pole, drove clear entering the stretch and angled out to the three path, widened advantage being kept to task. PLEASURE PEAKS hustled to the front, set all the pace running off the rail, headed mid turn, battled to upper stretch, yielded to the winner proving no match but did hold on well late saving second place. SLI NA GARPPLE trailed to the far turn, rallied five wide into the stretch, never menaced top pair but won the battle for third place. MAJESTIC VICTORY stalked to the far turn, bid three wide mid turn and loomed off the winner at the quarter pole, leveled off mid stretch and was edged out of third place in last jumps. SONOROUS VOICE rushed hard into the first turn, stalked PLEASURE PEAKS to the far turn, began to tire leaving the quarter pole, faded in the drive. OYSTER CAT lacked speed traveling five wide down the backside, dropped further off turning for home, showed little.
