Footnotes

PURE RUSH tracked evenly through the turn, angled seven wide in upper stretch surged late getting up at the wire. TETON STAR hustled out set the pace nursing a short lead through the turn, widened the margin in the four path upper stretch then was run down at the wire. IM GOOD AT THAT raced mid pack through the turn, saved ground to upper stretch bidding evenly late in the two path. MEOW GIBSON sent hard pressured the pace through the turn, extending in upper stretch would hang at mid track. QUIET EMARATI slow early angled inside upper stretch failing to menace. SLIVER away slowly was never involved. SECRET INFATUATION played no factor. KYLE'S TREASURY was always outrun. PETER THE GROSS showed early speed then gave way from between horses nearing the turn.
