**Footnotes**

ROSE N ANGELINA in tight brushing with BELIEVE A COUNTESS at the break, rushed to clear on opening turn, relaxed on moderate pace down the backside, maintained lead to 1/4 pole, angled off the inside facing inside pressure from DEJA VU DIVA in upper stretch, angled back to the inside under right handed urging, found more widening late. DEJA VU DIVA unhurried early, saved ground to the far turn, fired near the rail gaining quickly into stretch, angled to the outside as ROSE N ANGELINA dropped to the inside near the 1/16 pole, lost some momentum failing to menace late. MISS MARIA raced evenly into the backside, gave gradual retreat to the 1/4 pole, circled to mid track near the 1/8 pole, gave even response to best others. BELIEVE A COUNTESS in tight brushing with ROSE N ANGELINA at the break, hustled in pursuit of that one through the backside, loomed into the far turn, began to level from extensive use in upper stretch, had little left late. SAMEE BRASS raced evenly in second flight, had no surge under asking. OUR LEGEND taken back under hard restraint into the opening turn, roused for move leaving the backside, had no response. DOBIES LITTLE GIRL trailed early, had minimal improvement into the far turn, struggled under a drive. TOURS VAL rushed hard in early pursuit, chased ROSE N ANGELINA for a 1/2 mile before folding up. RAIN CAT was outrun early, gave way on the backside.
