Footnotes

BIG PUNCH quickly showed in front, led throughout traveling in the two path, drew off top of the lane, was kept to task in deep stretch holding safe. GRACEE'S TUITION settled in the second flight, split foes gaining momentum at the quarter pole, finished strongly picking up the place position. K'S DOWN AN OUT unhurried in the early stages, swung out seven wide top of the lane, hit stride mid stretch, surged willingly in deep stretch. SOLDIER BILL settled in the second flight, rallied five wide upper stretch, angled down to the rail in deep stretch and finished with good courage. SANTELLI raced up close running along the rail to the quarter pole, began to chase top of the stretch, weakened inside the eighth pole. SWINGING CHANGO made a slight hop as the gate opened, lagged far off the early pace, found stride upper stretch, angled wide at the eighth pole, gave belated action but never menaced. STORM LOVE head a good early stalking position, lacked response when asked for more and tired from mid stretch. NOONTIME BADGE tracked to the quarter pole, angled to the rail upper stretch, lacked rally and weakened from mid stretch. SHOOTER'S MARK stalked the winner from the start, loomed at the quarter pole racing three wide, began to give way in mid stretch, used up. AT A BOY CHARLIE raced briefly in mid pack, dropped off leaving the quarter pole finishing well beaten.
