MELVINTHEMUSICMAN broke awkwardly and took up leaving the gate, was angled to the rail while trailing to the half, advanced mid turn along the inside, angled out top of the lane, drew even mid stretch then drew off late being ridden out. SOCIAL WORKER set a pressured pace to the half, moved well clear midway on the second turn, was hard ridden form upper stretch as the lead had diminished, proved no match late for the winner but was easily second best. OURAGANS ROAR raced up close entering the backstretch, was in tight running along the rail and steadied at the five eighths pole, recovered and tracked to mid turn, came again at the quarter pole making a bold bid, failed to sustain rally and leveled off in upper stretch besting rest. PADDY TAP pressed the runner up to the half, could not keep pace coming to the quarter pole, faded upper stretch. EXCLUSIVE DAN SIR well paced traveling four wide to the far turn, gave way mid turn, well beaten. BARNWALD CAPPIE was quickly outrun racing wide down the backside, never involved. WELLINGTON DRIVE stalked to the half racing four wide, stopped near the quarter pole, was eased to the finish line finishing spent.
