KYLE'S PAL slow early gained ground four wide to upper stretch, dropped down to the two path inside the eighth pole driving up gamely. BAIL BONDSMAN tracked the pace through the turn, taken seven wide in upper stretch pressed hard in the final yards. BEST IN EGBERT away slowly was outrun through the turn, swung eight wide in upper stretch threatened in the closing yards. CORREDORS CLASSIC sent hard pressed the pace carrying a short lead to upper stretch, angling out from the three to the five path under left hand urging weakened. SIMON RIDGE pressured the pace through the turn, dueling at mid track in upper stretch tired late. FITZ N GIGGLES broke alertly pressuring the pace through the turn, extending in bid from the four path in upper stretch would fold late. L'S LEGACY played no factor racing seven wide through the lane. EUCLID AVENUE a step slow throughout was never involved. BAD POWER faded on the turn.
