TIP ALONG lagged behind for six furlongs, rallied top of the lane, bid between foes mid stretch, angled to the rail a sixteenth out, surged late under an all out drive, got up late in a four way battle to the finish line. IT'S TIFFIN TIME tracked under a rating to midway on the second turn, swung four wide coming into the stretch, vied abreast rivals in deep stretch, was out nodded in last jumps missing in a very hard effort. LEDGE'S MONARCHOS settled nicely running a little off the rail, asked from the quarter pole, bid in tandem vying for the lead upper stretch, vied racing between foes at the eighth pole, was outgamed late despite receiving severe left handed stick. SPIN THE WHEEL stalked along the rail entering the backside, took back at the half, angled out mid turn, came four wide upper stretch, vied mid stretch in a four way battle, was outfinished in last jumps, good try. UNRULY STORM pressed for the lead racing two wide throughout, edged clear in upper stretch, headed from both sides inside the eighth pole, weakened late being outfinished for a minor award. CHANG broke out but was quickly rushed into the first turn, cleared entering the backside and angled to the rail, dueled for the lead for six furlongs, began to tire upper stretch, used up. BOYSI'MHERE lacked speed and raced wide down the backside, dropped off to trail midway on the second turn finishing well beaten.
