BEA'S TREASURE was perfectly placed in the early going stalking a pair of duelers, moved three wide leaving the quarter pole, drew even with ON TOUR in upper stretch, slowly edged clear in deep stretch to win going away under strong handling. ON TOUR hustled from the gate, dueling along the rail throughout, fought hard when headed by BEA'S TREASURE in upper stretch, yielded stubbornly proving second best. VALID VENTURE was off slowly trailing in the opening strides, made a steady advance mid turn racing along the rail, angled out to mid stretch inside the eighth pole, finished willingly holding the show position. SAMURAI PRINCE settled in mid pack, raced between foes mid turn, swung out six wide upper stretch, mildly bid in the lane but never menaced. MR. KEEPER raced evenly in mid pack, swung out widest racing in the seven path upper stretch, failed to threaten besting rest. CHAMP KAMAL sent hard leaving the gate, battled for the lead to mid turn, began to give way mid stretch, used up. AUDITORIUM varied little racing in the second flight. WYO BANDITO raced briefly in mid pack, gave way from the quarter pole. MONTECORE lunged at the break, rushed a four wide move at the quarter pole, loomed entering the stretch, failed to sustain bid and stopped at the sixteenth pole. MILKY MAY was always outrun, failed to respond when roused mid turn, offered little.
