LUCK AND LIES quickly showed in front and controlled the tempo throughout, was asked for more leaving the quarter pole, held all rivals safe and won comfortably under steady handling. RIVER CARD stalked the winner from the start, angled out top of the stretch taking aim, was kept at bay and dug in late saving second place. TOUCHDOWNTONY rated early traveling in the second flight, advanced along the rail coming to the quarter pole, chased throughout the stretch run, missed second place in a good effort. COOL THUNDER stalked the winner to the far turn, began to drop off midway on the second turn, finished spent besting rest. NORTHERN CHAMP raced evenly racing at mid track, gave way entering the stretch, no factor. PLAYER'S LIST lagged far off the early pace, went by two weary foes turning for home, never involved. ROYAL CHAPEL lacked speed, gave way top of the stretch and was eased a furlong out. THUNDER COUNTRY gave way on the far turn, was eased in mid stretch but completed the course.
