ALCHOLIDAY hustled to the front, angled towards the inside while setting all of the pace, put away FOUR BOOTS in upper stretch, was then threatened by I AM THE KING in mid stretch, was asked for more and responded to increase margin in deep stretch. I AM THE KING well placed throughout, rallied along the rail entering the stretch, loomed off the winner in mid stretch, was turned away but gamely proved to be second best. ROMA'S SOLDIER settled in mid pack, was roused mid turn, split foes mid stretch, finished willingly gaining the show position. VY VY VY was a step slow into stride, came six wide entering the stretch, found best stride too late, finished strongly. STROLL WITH ME raced in good tracking position, traveled four to five wide under left handed whip entering the stretch, lacked late kick. DANCE IT UP lacked speed, moved over to the rail, saved ground throughout, failed to threaten. HERE COMES SCOOTER was slow into stride, raced in the second flight, failed to menace. FOUR BOOTS showed good speed, stalked the winner from the start, moved to a menacing position nearing the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and weakened mid stretch. PRANKSTER JACK hustled giving chase to the quarter pole, was all done giving way entering the stretch. POLISH SAUSAGE flashed brief foot in the opening strides, quickly retreated going into the far turn, no factor.
