Footnotes

LOCH DUBH slow early found stride surging out of the turn to grab the lead then drew off under a drive. PASTER'S BAD HABIT slow early saved ground into the turn, circled off the inside gave a quick move to upper stretch then had no where to go traveling behind a trio of rivals, was swung out finding room near mid track coming on late to salvage place. SABER DANCER gave prompted pursuit into the turn, joined LOCH DUBH outside the three sixteenths pole dueling on the inside of rival to upper stretch, couldn't sustain the effort while gradually wearing down the final eighth. HIEROGLYPHIC outrun early was never involved passing tired ones down the lane. AVELINA'S TICKET moved evenly throughout proving no factor. PARAMEDIC sent hard would press then chase through the turn, began to labor outside the eighth pole dropping off along the rail late. BALM BEACH lunged at the break, played no factor. COSACO PANDY crowded by PASTER'S BAD HABIT in the early going would labor. ARLINGTON PLACE rushed out pressuring the pace taking a clear lead on the turn, would wilt upon reaching the stretch. SNAZZI LIGHT hustled out would press early then chase on the turn, had nothing left in upper stretch and was eased to the wire.
