Footnotes

PALMETTO MOON tracked to the quarter pole racing three wide, asked for more turning for home, quickly blew by a faltering DIVINE ONE inside the eighth pole, held off a fast closing BURI under steady handling to the finish. BURI broke out bumping MO STAR and took up briefly and trailed soon after, gained momentum entering the stretch, angled out six in upper stretch, hit best stride mid stretch and finished full of run picking up second place in a good effort. DIVINE ONE was brushed in a chain reaction leaving the gate, quickly rushed up to take control, set a solid pace traveling along the inside, shortened stride at the sixteenth pole, was all done coming to the wire but managed to hold onto third place. MO STAR was bumped by BURI at the break causing the rider to take up, hustled up to track the pace racing along the rail, needed more in deep stretch while besting rest. CHUALO settled in the second flight racing mid track, mildly bid in mid stretch running between rivals, leveled off needing more late. KING BEE pressed for the early lead, gave chase from the quarter pole under urging, lacked bid and gave way late finishing spent. NELLA'S MANGAS settled in the second flight, lacked response when asked, no threat. SEARCH raced briefly in mid pack, weakened mid turn, no factor. J'S REDBUD SPIRIT offered little racing wide throughout.
