WHY IZZY WHY settled nicely traveling in mid pack, rallied three wide entering the stretch, raced abreast rivals in upper stretch, came in to bump SHE'S A LISTENER nearing the eighth pole, drove clear late prevailing under urging. THREE SIXTY rated early traveling towards the rear, swung out five wide top of the stretch, surged late grabbing second place in a willing manner. SHE'S A LISTENER raced up close from the start, bid between foes vying for the lead at the quarter pole, was bumped and steadied briefly in mid stretch, battled hard to the wire being edged out of second place late in a good effort. DADDY'S APPLE broke alertly, hustled along the rail to duel for the lead, vied from the quarter pole to mid stretch, weakened late in a good try. KUTLOOSE sent hard, held a head lead around the bend, vied in a four way battle turning for home running between foes, was in tight losing position in upper stretch, swung wide trying to re-rally, lacked punch tiring in the drive. DID YOU KNOW well placed tracking a contested pace, roused from the quarter pole, lacked rally coming up empty in the drive. DENALI TIZAWINNER was always outrun racing wide. SUGAR SHENANIGAN'S lacked speed, swung out to the six path upper stretch under a drive, offered little. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS FOLLOWED BY A CLAIM OF FOUL FROM THE RIDER OF SHE'S A LISTENER AGAINST THE RIDER OF WHY IZZY WHY FOR INTERFERENCE IN MID STRETCH, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED AND RESULTS STOOD AS IS.
