FILLAZZENNE well rated set the pace nursing a short lead through the far turn, dug in to outside pressure in the two path angled out a bit holding well late. WHERE'S MIMI stalked the pace through the backside looming boldly abreast the pacesetter to upper stretch, extended in the three path was tightened up a bit while being turned away late. BRIDAL VISION slow early saved ground while advancing on the far turn, angling off the rail mid stretch would hang late. PROVEN WYNNER stayed back through the far turn then gained belatedly from mid track late. BLINGWHERE'SMYRING stalked the pace giving chase through the far turn then weakened in the four path upper stretch. MY HONEY'S HONEY was always outrun finishing up seven wide. ROGER'S JULIE played no factor finishing along the inside. SUNSET SUMMER showed little. PROPER N PRIM was eased to the wire.
