SHOPPED OUT prompted the pace wresting a short lead near the half, working under pressure through the far turn would dig in from the three path upper stretch holding off an inside challenge from JAYCEETEE to prevail. JAYCEETEE unhurried early fired to contention on the far turn, bid boldly inside of SHOPPED OUT from the two path upper stretch extending late to no avail. FLATTER ME FIRST away slowly gave a mild response on the far turn, circled six wide in upper stretch bid evenly late. WANTA GO stalked through the backside pressing up to challenge SHOPPED OUT on the far turn, wavered into upper stretch dropping off at mid track. FLATTER ME UP well rated moved to bid on the far turn then wilted along the inside in upper stretch. LADY FLICKER saving ground was never involved. TRISTANME folding up early was put away down the stretch. ANA KENA hustled out would prompt the pace through the backside, used up on the far turn was eased down the stretch.
