VITAL ARGUMENT sent hard worked the pace keeping a head in front through the turn, dueling inside of BEA'S TREASURE down the lane would dig deep in the three path prevailing gamely. BEA'S TREASURE breaking sharply pressured the pace racing abreast VITAL ARGUMENT through the turn into upper stretch, extending there in the four path gave all to the end. PORT HUDSON stalked close up through the turn, looming abreast dueling rivals from mid track in upper stretch lacked needed surge. GUSKA'S GOLD hustled in pursuit chased from the two path to upper stretch, dropping to the rail would extend late being outfinished. ROUNDUP JADE raced evenly through the turn angling six wide in upper stretch, lacked late response. DUTY ROSTER slow early was swung out six wide in mid stretch improving little. CALL THE GUY chased close up through the turn, fading along the rail in upper stretch would angle to the three path late. TRIPPIN' AWAY breaking slowly played no factor. BAIRDS VILLAGE was always a step slow finishing along the rail. WYO BANDITO was never involved. VITAL ARGUMENT WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED FOR MEDICATION VIOLATION.
