EVENING CONCERTO stalked a pair of duelers to the far turn, bid three wide mid turn for the lead, moved clear entering the stretch, was under an all out drive coming to the wire, just held on being fully extended. NICKY'S DELIGHT rated early, sat patient to the quarter pole, rallied four wide taking aim on EVENING CONCERTO mid stretch, surged on that rival at the wire just missing in a solid effort. HARPERS LAND lagged far off the pace to mid turn, swung five wide entering the stretch, loomed off of top pair mid stretch, needed more late. COUNTRY HUMOR unhurried racing towards the rear, rallied upper stretch, bid between foes in deep stretch, finished willingly. POINTMAN TALKIN raced in mid pack along the inside, bid to a menacing position at the quarter pole, flattened out inside the eighth pole. PEGASUS ENA well placed tracking the pace traveling off the rail, gave chase form the quarter pole, lacked rally and tired in the drive. MARK JUMPS raced briefly in mid pack, faded on the turn racing mid track, no factor. HIGH ACT pressed then dueled mid turn running between foes at the three eighths, gave way upper stretch, used up. BABU set a pressured pace running along the rail for six furlongs, stopped entering the stretch finishing spent.
