JOHN'S BURGER tracked evenly through the turn, bid abreast MARYLOVESTETON in upper stretch extending up in the six path. MARYLOVESTETON broke alertly setting the pace through the turn, digging in from the two path angled out toward mid track dueling inside of JOHN'S BURGER ceding grudgingly. BUCK CASH tracked the pace through the turn saving ground to upper stretch, extending on the rail proved no match while holding position. SHOW ME THE CASH chased the pace through the turn then dropped off the leaders into upper stretch finishing evenly in the three path. NOBLE CAVALIER slow early improved a bit at mid track down the stretch. RONALDO hustled out gave hard pursuit through the turn then wore out along the inside in upper stretch. FREE COUNTRY played no factor racing seven wide through the stretch. GOALTOGOAL was always outrun. MOUNTAIN A. P. chased through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. EVAN'S EMERALD slow early would tire.
