Footnotes

FINAL CURTAIN unhurried early saved ground to upper stretch surging inside of rivals getting up gamely. SWEEP FIRST slow early advanced on the backside, chased to upper stretch then drifted eight wide under left hand urging missing at the wire. TEMPESTUOUS ONE sent clear set the pace through the far turn, hooked between horses in upper stretch would cede late. GENERAL STALLINGS away slowly circled out to upper stretch, bid willingly late at mid track. FINAL FITZ slow early played no factor. MIRROR BALL stalked the pace chasing through the far turn, wore out in upper stretch. ADVISE AND CONSENT gave a mild middle move then flattened out into upper stretch. KIOTARI BAY stalked close up to the half, weakened on the far turn giving way to upper stretch. LITTLE SAM FRENCH hustled along was done after a half mile. SUAVE FOX was pulled up and vanned off.
