FOURTH TOP broke sharply taking control, angled towards the rail setting all the pace, drew off turning for home, won easily being ridden out. FUNKY COUNTRY tracked racing a little off the rail, swung out four wide upper stretch, closed willingly picking up second place but never threatened the winner. HONEST EXPECTATION stalked the winner down the backstretch, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole, chased throughout the stretch run and was edged out late of the place position. GENERAL STAFF rated early saving ground throughout, mildly gained in upper stretch, was outfinished late vying for minor awards. THE BIG STORY settled in mid pack, came six wide under a stiff drive into the lane, failed to respond, never menaced. FARLEYSHELONWHEELS was urged shortly after the start but lacked response trailing to mid turn, swung seven wide entering the stretch, gave some belated interest improving position but never threatened. PALATINATE lacked speed and raced towards the inside, roused to no avail, no factor. UNSUNG ANGELS raced wide around the turn in the second flight, showed little. SEA DOCTOR hustled early racing up close to the quarter pole, started to fade upper stretch, no late factor.
