Footnotes

JAZZ MASTER nicely rated running mid pack and along the inside, asked at the quarter pole and angled four wide entering the stretch, collared duelers inside the furlong marker, drew off late under strong handling. AMPHIBIOUS ASSAULT was a step slow into stride and settled towards the rear, saved ground to upper stretch, angled out mid stretch and closed strongly gaining the place position. FIDDLERS JINGO sent hard leaving the gate, battled in a three way duel to the quarter pole, vied to deep stretch but would prove no match late but held well holding on to third place. FLY BY MOONLIGHT was rushed hard from the gate, alternated for the lead running along the rail, battled to deep stretch, faded late in a good effort. DAKOTA FREEWAY lacked speed and trailed to top of the lane, split foes mid stretch finding best stride, closed with interest picking up a minor award. BOLD JEWELLER lacked speed racing towards the rear, slightly improved position but never threatened. FLYINGPALM delayed the start a bit when removed from the gate to have a vet check, was cleared to run and reloaded, sent hard and vied for the lead running between foes to the quarter pole, dropped off leaving the quarter pole and was no factor in the lane. LANDRY settled in the second flight, lacked response when asked for more, never threatened. RISING THUNDER was hustled early racing up close traveling four to five wide around the bend, started to weaken entering the stretch and faded throughout the drive.
