Footnotes

HOLLY'S PAL engaged the early pace grabbing a short lead on the turn then shook clear into upper stretch, hand ridden the final eighth would widen gamely. LONG CHASE pressed then chased HOLLY'S AL through the turn, dispatched by the winner in upper stretch would need all abreast GOLD C D late to salvage place. GOLD C D outrun early saved ground cutting the corner to contention in upper stretch, responded willingly from the rail to the finish. BLAZINETT chased early then dropped off on the turn, had some recovery angling four wide in upper stretch giving even late action. KING'S LAW was hustled out pressing then chasing through the turn, weakened into upper stretch. REDO THE COURT pressed hard between horses then gave all out pursuit on the turn, was used up entering the stretch. KATMANBLU a bit unruly was steadied from the gate, would labor through the turn then swing seven wide in upper stretch. WHERE'S THE MONEY was always outrun. THISCATSAGENTLEMAN showed little. GREAT ZARB dropped back early.
