TRIVIUM sent hard from the gate, quickly cleared and angled towards the rail, was kept to task from mid stretch, began to shorten stride late and just lasted being fully extended. PULPIT'S JET stalked the winner throughout, closed gap in deep stretch under an all out drive, drifted out nearing the finish line just missing in a game effort. PULASKI COUNTY was forwardly placed down the backside, bid four wide top of the lane, was outgamed in deep stretch despite being hard ridden needing a bit more. SHORE TEE settled in the second flight running along the rail, angled out mounting bid in upper stretch, split foes at the eighth pole, bested rest in good try. GAME OF SKILL was outrun racing off the rail down the backstretch, mildly bid in the stretch improving placing but never threatened. WINTER KNIGHT hustled early running along the rail, moved to a menacing position at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and weakened mid stretch. WHERE'S THE MONEY gave a brief early chase traveling five wide around the bend, faded leaving the quarter pole. DOCTOR BOROS was always a step slow, offered little. BRADLEY ducked out leaving the gate, trailed leaving the far turn, never involved.
