HUMOR'S PUNCH dueled down the backstretch running between foes, left the field behind turning for home, was kept to task while increasing margin as much the best. ALL THE GLORY settled in mid pack, came three to four wide top of the stretch, finished willingly securing the place position late but never threatened the winner. DUTY ROSTER raced sluggish down the backside, trailed to mid turn, angled to the four path upper stretch, found stride and finished strongly picking up the show position. BETTER BELIEVE tracked running off the rail, made a mild move entering the stretch, was outfinished late fighting for a minor award. FLYINGPALM pressed the winner to the far turn, gave chase traveling three to four wide leaving the quarter pole, faded from mid stretch. TAKE AIM settled in the second flight, angled out upper stretch, slightly improved placing but was no factor. CHICKASAW KID raced evenly while off the rail, roused to no avail, failed to factor. R. CAMPFIRE was always outrun racing wide, never involved. PETER THE GROSS rushed shortly after the start, came in going into the far turn herding TWELVE HUNDRED, pressed briefly for the lead, was all done and gave way in upper stretch. TWELVE HUNDRED hustled from the gate, pressed briefly for the early lead, had path taken away going into the far turn by PETER THE GROSS and clipped heels off that rival and stumbled badly, was soon eased but did complete the course. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS FOLLOWED BY A RIDERS CLAIM OF FOUL FROM THE RIDER OF TWELVE HUNDRED AGAINST THE RIDER OF PETER THE GROSS FOR INTERFERENCE ON THE FAR TURN, AFTER REVIEW, PETER THE GROSS WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST.
