Footnotes

THE ONE TO CHASE stalked to mid turn, bid for the lead and took over near the quarter pole, drew off from upper stretch and was kept to task winning comfortably. MIRACLE HILL was a step slow into stride, raced very wide throughout, rallied from upper stretch to gain the place position in willing effort. HIGHLAND MIST settled towards the rear, advanced mid turn, came five wide into the lane, was outgamed in deep stretch vying for second place. TRAVELEZE stalked along the rail to the quarter pole, swung out four wide under a drive top of the lane, failed to threaten needing more. RIGHTEOUS TIGER tracked early racing mid track, was hard ridden from the quarter pole and moved into second place chasing the winner in upper stretch, tired inside the furlong marker. DANCING IN GERARDA broke alertly and angled to the rail setting the pace, headed midway on the bend by the winner, had little left giving way mid stretch, spent.
