ONE MORE RUBY went evenly, shuffled back on turn, altered course, mild rally. MISS ALLIANCE dropped well back, labored to lane, passed tiring rivals. PROSPECTOR DUMAANI well placed, tracked pace, weakened. AINT MY FIRST TIME rated back, rallied boldly second turn, wavered in drive, empty. FOXTROT PATTY hustled to front, chased pace, dueled on turn, wore out. J. C.'S JEWEL broke sharply, set pace, tired. GRANNA bad step, pulled up.
