MISS MARNI pressured the pace while in hand, dueled to the lead nearing the furlong pole then held on under a steady drive. MERLOT MOMENT, off the pace, ran five wide through the turn, made her bid from the top of the stretch and closed well to place. SILVERTON BAY was kept close to the pace down the backstretch, stayed in the four path through the turn and offered a mild steady stretch bid. TANGIER SOUND set a pressured pace, maintained a slight edge through the upper stretch, dropped back inside nearing the eighth pole and weakened from there. IZAMAL raced widest through the backstretch just off the pace, bolted through the turn then finished wide. PROUD PHANTOM raced off the pace saving ground and offered no rally. DOUBLE EX was never a factor. NATURAL REACTION was steadied slightly at the start and was no factor after.
