EAST TO WEST set the pace on the inside, dueled on the turn and drew off, driving. MAKE IT SPECIAL raced off the pace, moved up three wide on the turn, rallied and was up late for second. BLACK TIE SPIRIT chased four wide early, bid three wide on the turn and weakened. ON TIME SOMETIME was pinched back at the break, saved ground on the turn, angled out and gained mildly. ZONE BREAKER chased three wide, bid between on the turn and tired. BACKBACKBACKGONE chased inside and tired. PAPER BACK SAINT failed to threaten. BEST JAZZ came four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. TRIPLE A. RATING chased five wide, four wide on the turn and faded. LAST STAR chased between rivals and gave way.
