VERY HALL rated a short lead off the rail, drew clear approaching the eighth pole then widened under steady encouragement. CIGNO D'ORO rated back toward the outside, started her drive leaving the quarter pole and was just up for place. SMART N CLASSY was unprepared and hopped at the start, recovered gradually through the backstretch, continued that momentum inside on the turn, eased out into the lane and was outfinished for place. PASSAIC rated just off the pace toward the inside, bid four wide on the turn then leveled off in the stretch. IRISH SOVEREIGN rated with the early pace inside, gave chase entering the stretch but faded the final furlong. KEY TO LOVE rated off the early pace toward the outside, bid into the turn then had no stretch response. CRYPTOFEM showed no speed inside, eased out for the drive and offered a mild bid. OUT OF THE WILL chased the pace from the inside and was outrun. SATIATE bobbled slightly at the start and was outrun. WILDWOOD CREST gave chase from the four path and weakened nearing the quarter pole. SENSITIVE PENGUIN bobbled slightly at the start then was through early.
