C C'S PAL set the pace on the inside, dug in gamely in upper stretch, lost the lead past midstretch, battled back determinedly on the rail and got the nod. SWEET N SOUR NINA raced off the pace, moved up outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, closed willingly, surged late outside and just missed. SUCCESSFUL SONG stalked in the two path, commenced her bid turning for home, put a head in front a sixteenth out and dug in gamely between rivals to the finish. ACRONYM moved off the rail entering the clubhouse turn, then went back inside, was steadied in tight quarters at the five eighths marker, tracked and lacked a stretch response. REPREIVE raced three wide early, settled off the pace and failed to respond. POWER BID saved ground and did not factor.
